“What if you can't afford a will?”

AARP Tax Prep will take place at the Boyle Center this year beginning February 6th. Please call 208-991-3021 and leave a message with your name and phone number to schedule an appointment. Appointments will be available Mon., Tues. and Weds. mornings thru April. Single seniors must file a tax return when their taxable income is over \$14,700 (income outside of social security earnings) in 2022. If their filing status is married filing jointly, they will need to file when their taxable income is over \$27,300. For 2022, people over 65, single, and who have more than \$14,250 in income **outside of their social security income** will need to file a tax return. Seniors who are married will need to file if their non-social security income is over \$28,700.
