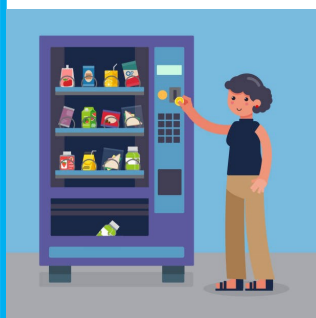

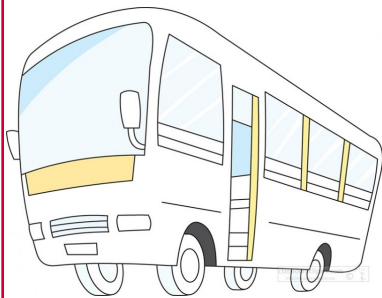

# FARMERS MARKET COUPONS

Cayuga County Office for the Aging will be distributing **Farmers Market Coupons** this year via **Drive-Thru Distribution Sites**. Distribution will happen from the convenience of your vehicle! We encourage you to attend one of the distributions below due to limited coupon quantities. For more information, please call 315-253-1550.

## Rules and Procedures for All Locations:

- ◆ Clients will remain in their vehicles at all times. A staff member will distribute the necessary eligibility paperwork and coupon booklets via your vehicle's window.
- ◆ Clients must pick up their own coupons. Individuals with proof of POA or Proxy (official NYS proxy form can be found on our website or mailed upon request) can sign for the coupons and pick up multiple coupons for each individual POA/Proxy.
- ◆ Please be patient as the lines may be long, but wait times should be short.
- ◆ **FARMERS MARKET COUPON ELIGIBILITY: 1.) You must be age 60 or older 2.) Monthly income at/or below \$2,248 one person household; \$3,040 two person household; etc 3.) One coupon booklet, per person, per year**
